OPPOSE HOUSE BILL 5615

The So-Called Reproductive Justice and Access Act

In the Illinois General Assembly, Representatives **Barbara Flynn Currie** (D-Chicago) and **Rosemary Mulligan** (R-Des Plaines) have recently introduced House Bill 5615, known as the Reproductive and Justice Access Act. Planned Parenthood's political apparatus has begun an intensive push to pass this legislation.

The enactment of House Bill 5615 would ensure the following:

- The government WILL NOT be allowed any regulation of abortion (parental notification, ban on partial birth abortion, etc.);
- Medicaid funding WILL BE be used for abortions;
- Illinois' Health Care Right of Conscience Act WILL cease to exist;
- Comprehensive sex education for every student in Illinois public schools, kindergarten through 12, WILL BE MANDATED!
