2008 Voter Guide | U.S. Congressional Candidate Survey Questions

U.S. Congressional candidates were asked if they **Support** or **Oppose**:

- 1 | **Unborn Child Pain Awareness Act**, which would ensure that women seeking an abortion are fully informed regarding the pain experienced by their fetus. (H.R. 6099 - 2006)
- 2 | **Stem Cell Research Enhancement Act**, which would allow federal funding of stem cell research on lines of stem cells derived from human embryos. (H.R. 3 - 2007)
- 3 | Adding "sexual orientation" to federal "Hate Crime" laws. (H.R. 1592 - 2007)
- 4 | **The Family and Consumer Choice Act**, which would provide consumers the ability to choose and pay for only the cable networks they want. (H.R. 2738)
- 5 | A federal marriage amendment defining marriage as between one man and one woman in the U.S. Constitution. (HJ Res 88 - 2006)
- 6 | Federal legislation making it a federal offense to transport a minor across state lines for an abortion if this is done to evade a state parental involvement law. (H.R. 748 - 2005 Child Interstate Abortion Notification Act.)
- 7 | **Reduce taxes by expanding the per-child tax credit.**
- 8 | **The Pledge Protection Act**, which would remove the jurisdiction of federal courts over cases involving the Pledge of Allegiance. (H.R. 2389 - 2006)
- 9 | **Employment Non-Discrimination Act**, which would prohibit discrimination against employees on the basis of "sexual orientation."
- 10 | **Federal funding of Planned Parenthood and any other organization that performs abortions, both in the U.S. and abroad (even if they use money from other sources).**

IL House & IL Senate candidates were asked if they Support or Oppose:

- 1 | Taxpayer funding of live human embryonic stem cell research. (S.B. 4 - 2007)
- 2 | Creating "Civil Unions" for same-sex couples having all the same benefits and legal protections as marriage. (H.B. 1826 - 2007)
- 3 | Allowing pharmacists to dispense "morning after" pills (e.g. Plan B) to minors without requiring parental notice or a doctor evaluation. (H.B. 1077 - 2007)
- 4 | Legislation requiring public libraries to filter/block Internet access to illegal obscenity, child pornography, and material harmful to minors. (H.B. 1727 - 2007)
- 5 | Legislation to expand gambling in Illinois with casinos or additional slot machines. (H.B. 2035 - 2007 and H.B. 2651 - 2008)
- 6 | Federal Equal Rights Amendment (ERA) that will require gender-based "equal rights" including protecting "abortion rights" and "same-sex marriages." (HJRCA 2 - 2007)
- 7 | Legislation to provide grants for "comprehensive sex education" which will include instructing students from ages 9-17 about condom usage and birth control. (S.B. 2267- 2006)
- 8 | Legislation permitting authorized persons to legally possess no more than 12 marijuana plants and 2.5 ounces of useable cannabis. (S.B. 650 - 2007)
- 9 | Legislation creating new school health clinics that can distribute birth control to students. (S.B. 715 - 2007)
