House Bill 2234 is a stepping stone to legalizing same-sex “marriage”. Read this quote from a letter signed by 27 gay activists, printed in the November 19, 2008 Windy City Times.

“..Most crucially, we should make clear that we expect our endorsed candidate (sic) to unequivocally support full marriage equality. No longer should we accept candidates who attempt to straddle the fence by opposing marriage equality while supporting civil unions.”

House Bill 2234 passed out of the Youth and Family Committee on March 5th and could be called for a vote in the House at any time. If this bill becomes law, government-funded schools will teach children that homosexual behavior is normal.
