## 2010 Voter Guide | Senate & U.S. Congressional Candidate Survey Questions

*U.S. Congressional candidates were asked if they Support or Oppose:*

- 1 | Tax Increase/Cap and Trade — will tax energy consumption to combat “global warming.” (American Clean Energy and Security Act - 2009)
- 2 | “Hate Crimes” legislation — allows 2 identical crimes to be prosecuted differently if one victim is homosexual, a cross dresser or transsexual. (H.R.1913 - 2009)
- 3 | Employment Non-Discrimination Act of 2009 (ENDA) — gives homosexual and transsexual individuals protected class status in the workplace. (H.R.3017 & S.1584 - 2009)
- 4 | REPEAL of Defense of Marriage Act (DOMA) — the repeal of the only federal law that prevents homosexual “marriage” from becoming legal across the country (H.R.3567 - 2009)
- 5 | Government Health Care — A government managed insurance plan that includes a “Public Option” similar to Medicare. (H.R.3200, H.R.3962 or U.S. Senator Max Baucus’ plan - 2009)
- 6 | Defund A.C.O.R.N. Act (H.R.3571 - 2009)
- 7 | Unborn Child Pain Awareness Act of 2006 — requires abortionists to tell mothers about fetal development and the capacity of preborn children to feel pain. (H.R.6099 - 2006)
- 8 | REPEAL of “Don’t Ask, Don’t Tell” — would repeal the law that prohibits openly practicing homosexuals from serving in the military. (H.R.1283 - 2009)
- 9 | Requiring the 2010 census to include the question “Are you a citizen of the United States of America?” (Senate Amendment 2644 to H.R.2847 - 2009)
- 10 | Transfer of prisoners from Guantanamo Bay to U.S. facilities. (H.R.2647, Sec. 1041 of Conference Report - 2009)

2010 Voter Guide | IL Statewide, Senate & House Candidate Survey Questions

Statewide, Senate & House candidates were asked if they Support or Oppose:

- Civil Unions — marriage benefits for same-sex partners. ( HB 2234, House Amendment 1 to SB 1716 – 2009)
- Reproductive Health & Access Act — removes all IL abortion restrictions. (HB 2354 - 2009)
- Tax/Fee/Gambling increase to provide revenue for \$31 billion "Build Illinois" capital program: authorized 5 video gambling machines in establishments serving liquor; increased tax on candy bars and alcohol; increased fees for license plates and driver's licenses. (HB 255 – 2009)
- Medical Marijuana — permits authorized persons to legally grow and possess up to 6 marijuana plants and 2 ounces of marijuana. (SB 1381 – 2009)
- Equal Rights Amendment — ratifies the federal ERA thus eliminating all gender-based distinctions (widows collecting husband's social security, gender-exclusive schools and organizations such as Boy Scouts, would usher in same-sex marriage, would remove restrictions on all abortion procedures and would require young women to register for the selective service). (HJRCA 3 – 2009)
- Marriage Amendment — would place a ballot referendum before IL voters asking if the IL Constitution should be amended to define marriage as the union of one man and one woman. (HJRCA 2 – 2009)
- Sex Education — requires schools to teach undefined "age-appropriate" information on sexuality which, according to national SEICUS guidelines, includes training in condom usage and presents homosexuality as a positive alternative lifestyle. (SB 2267 - 2006)
- State Income Tax Increase from 3 to 4.5 %. (House Amendment 4 to SB 2252 – 2009)
- Authorizes an IL driver's license certificate to illegal aliens. (HB 1100 – 2007)
